<p>School Class Guides 16 people per day 8:00 am orientation – no later than 3:00 pm</p>	<p>Guide a school class from greeting the bus to leading the class to their next demonstration throughout the day. You will be observing the demonstrations with the class. There is a ½ hour lunch break. We supply a free lunch for you and a free ticket to come back to the rendezvous over the weekend.</p>
<p>Lunch Shelter Attendants 2 people per day 10:30 – approximately 2:00 pm</p>	<p>Help students and teachers in the lunch pavilion during lunch, encouraging students to put their litter in appropriate containers. After lunches pick up the pavilion and sweep up floor.</p>
<p>Archery Assistants 2 people per day 8:30 am – no later than 3:00 pm</p>	<p>Assist in keeping class lines in order while the students are waiting their turn</p>
<p>Hawk Assistant 1 people per day 8:30 am – no later than 3:00 pm</p>	<p>Assist in keeping class lines in order while the students are waiting their turn</p>
<p>General clean up 2 people per day After 3:30 pm</p>	<p>General clean up of grounds and empty garbage cans and reline them.</p>
<p>Demonstrator, Volunteer, Committee and Dog Soldier Lunch Attendants 2 people per day 10:00 am – approximately 2:00 pm</p>	<p>Set up potluck lunch and replenish food as required. Clean up at the end of the lunches.</p>
